जागरण संवाददाता, चंडीगढ़ : कार्मल कान्वेंट स्कूल में कक्षा 10 की छात्रा ओशीन मलेरी का चयन भारतीय अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान संगठन (इसरो) की प्रतिष्ठित युवा वैज्ञानिक कार्यक्रम युविका 2025 के लिए हुआ। यह कार्यक्रम 19 से 30 मई तक हुआ। देशभर से आए लगभग 4 लाख आवेदनों में से केवल 350 मेधावी छात्रों को इस खास दो सप्ताहिय आवासीय कार्यक्रम में शामिल होने का अवसर मिला। इस प्रोग्राम में काफी प्रतिभाशाली बच्चों को हिस्सा लेने का मौका मिलता है। ओशीन ने यह कार्यक्रम इसरो के यू आर राव सैटेलाइट सेंटर (यूआरएससी), बेंगलुरु में स्थित गेस्ट हाउस में अटेंड किया, जो उपग्रह निर्माण का प्रमुख केंद्र है। इस दौरान विद्यार्थियों को इसरो के प्रमुख केंद्रों का भ्रमण करने, विशेषज्ञ वैज्ञानिकों के व्याख्यान सुनने, और राकेट, सैटेलाइट तथा ड्रोन के निर्माण जैसे गतिविधियों में भाग लेने का अवसर मिला। ओशीन के अनुसार गगनयान मानव अंतरिक्ष मिशन की तैयारियों को प्रत्यक्ष रूप से देखना अद्भुत था। ओशीन उन चुनिंदा छात्रों में शामिल थीं जिन्हें इसरो के अंतरिक्ष यात्री कैटन अंगद प्रताप से मिलने और बातचीत करने का मौका मिला। कार्यक्रम में निदेशक एम. शंकरण से भी मुलाकात भी हुई जिन्होंने विद्यार्थियों को विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में अग्रणी बनने के लिए प्रेरित किया।




Athletics
